Autonomy to implement innovative approaches in exchange for being held to higher standards of accountability.

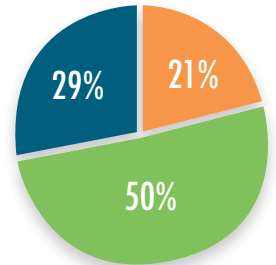

46,000 students total

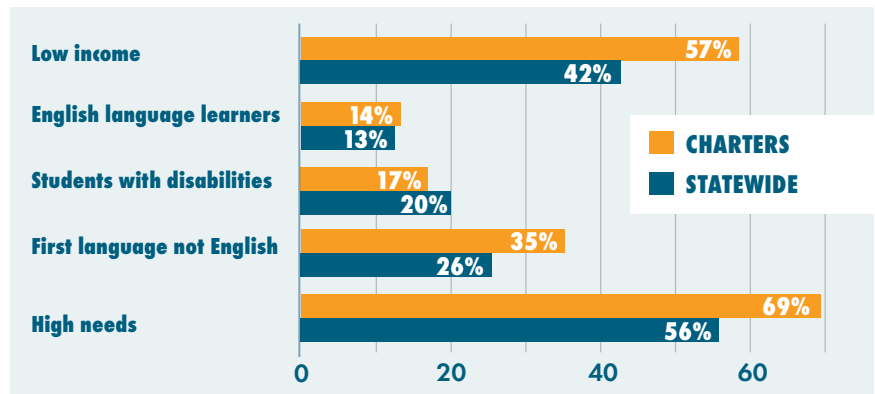

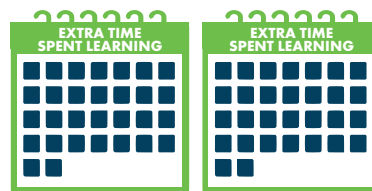

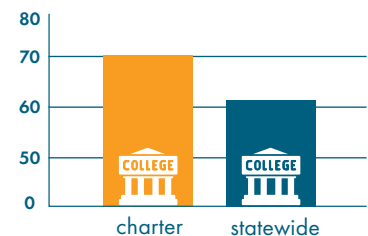
OUR OUTCOMES & IMPACT

Charter public school students are growing & learning rapidly.

Each year, Massachusetts charter public school students demonstrate the equivalent of **41 extra days of learning - or nearly 2 months of school** - in both reading and math, as compared with their district peers.



Graduates of Massachusetts charter public schools are **more likely to enroll in college**. 70% of charter public school graduates enroll in college, as compared with 62% statewide.
